

What is?

The HECATE project aims to improve the availability of information for both those with disabilities regarding the physical constraints within a city environment which hinder their movement and participation in events, as well as information regarding technological barriers for professionals working within this sector, in order to provide solutions to said limitations.

Objectives

The main aim of the project is the design, development and set up of a comprehensive system for the professional management of the global accessibility and city consulting and information, who will allow improving continuously the universal accessibility in public spaces. The system will be composed by two independent and “feedbacked” tools: the Tool for the Comprehensive Management of Accessibility (GIA) and of the Application of Consulting, Information and Routes (VADEO 2.0).

For who?

- Local entities or municipalities, local technician: the public entities will count on updated and precise information about the conditions of their tracks and infrastructures and will be able to use it for making a more efficient civil works and accessibility planning.
- Technical company in accessibility, accessibility technician: the companies and accessibility professionals will rely on a new tool to analyze, control and manage efficiently all the received data, improving the analysis and planning processes of universal accessibility.
- Citizens: the tool will bring the new technologies and social networks closer to the handicapped people, sharing the improvements of their environment with them.
- Associations and groups: of the environment associations and groups of handicapped people will be able to participate as well in this process of continuous improvement.
